

**JEFF DAVIS COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT
ORDER SETTING 2017 TAX RATE AND LEVYING AD VALOREM TAXES**

Whereas, the Jeff Davis County Commissioners Court for 2017, in order to provide funds with which to meet the budget requirements of the County, and to pay the expenses necessarily incurred in connection with the services provided by the County to Jeff Davis County residents: therefore,

BE IT ORDERED BY THE COMMISSIONERS COURT OF JEFF DAVIS COUNTY, TEXAS:

1. That there is hereby levied and there shall be assessed and collected for 2017 an ad valorem tax of \$.655621 per \$100 assessed valuation on all taxable property within the county as shown on the final approved 2017 tax rolls of the county.
2. THIS TAX RATE WILL RAISE MORE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS THAN LAST YEAR'S TAX RATE. THE TAX RATE WILL EFFECTIVELY BE RAISED BY 6.80% AND WILL RAISE TAXES FOR MAINTENANCE AND OPERATIONS. THE AMOUNT OF TAXES IMPOSED ON THE AVERAGE HOME WILL BE \$639.48
3. This tax rate is hereby adopted in the following components:

4. That the Jeff Davis County Sheriff/Tax Assessor-Collector is hereby authorized and directed to prepare 2017 tax statements and transmit the same to the owners of taxable property within the County on or before October 1, 2017, or as soon thereafter as possible.




